Services will be held this year in a very large outdoor marquee in the playground behind Od Yosef Hai, with sides that can be opened (weather permitting) allowing for 2 metres distance between seats. We are given priority to members, who will be allocated seats first to members who have applied by Sunday 30 August. Remaining seats are being allocated to non-members who have applied before that date on a first-come first-served basis. We will of course make every effort to accommodate everyone who applied before the deadline as we have in previous years. Important note: members and non-members who apply after Sunday 30 August will not be allocated fixed seats but, space permitting, will be welcome to use an area of non-reserved seating on a first-come first-served basis.
