Members of Magen Avot are eligible to apply for seats free of charge. Seats are available for children of members under the age of 18 for a contribution of £18 per seat. Non-members can purchase seats at the cost of £100 for adults and £30 for children (under 18). We are not able to accept charity cheques. Members and non-members should submit their booking straight away. However, in order to give priority to members, we will be allocating seats first to members who have applied by **Sunday 14 August**. Any remaining seats will be allocated to non-members who have applied before that date on a first-come first-served basis. We will of course make every effort to accommodate everyone who applies before the deadline as we have in previous years. Important note: members and non-members who apply after 14 August will not be allocated fixed seats but, space permitting, will be welcome to use an area of non-reserved seating on a first-come first-served basis. Its main objective is to promote the wellbeing of Israel's sons and daughters in uniform. UK AWIS is one of many branches around the world that actively raise funds for the wide range of projects and facilities that enhance the wellbeing of Israel's soldiers. A special department in the Human Resources of the IDF has been established to ensure that all donations for the soldiers go solely through this one gate.
