Profile: One of the US longest serving ministers, of Cockfosters and North Southgate, retired in 2013 after 27 years' service. Rabbi Fine was involved in building a new Jewish day school, a mikveh, a satellite community in Hadley Wood and many other projects that have enriched London Jewish life.

Originally from Swansea, Rabbi Fine entered the rabbinate in 1974 as minister of Newcastle Hebrew Congregation before moving to Wembley Synagogue and then to Cockfosters in 1987. The cricket-loving minister — a member of the MCC — also opened an adult education programme, the Cockfosters Learning Centre, in 2004.


