Additionally, as Chanuka and the winter break are at the same time we will have a mid-season break on 24th and 31st December (next two weeks).


Sunday 18 December EVENT – Booking Closed!



Some Chanukah safety tips for SHUL and IN THE HOME

- Always take care when lighting your Chanukia
- Always place your Chanukia away from curtains, paper, books or other flammable items
- Always make sure your Chanukia is standing on a firm level base
- Always ensure candles, wicks or oil containers are firmly seated in place
- Chanukah is the perfect time to test your smoke detectors are working
- Never leave a Chanukia unattended
- Never leave young children or pets unsupervised in the same room as a lit Chanukia
- Never walk around with lighted matches, candles or tapers
- Take special care of the suitability and safety of Chanukiot made specifically for arts, crafts and decorative purposes they may not be safe to use.
- Be especially careful if using glass oil holders as these become very hot and may crack and tip over.
- If candles or containers fall over, smother the flame immediately with a damp cloth.
- Don't play with Fire!
