# Motzei Shabbat 23 March

As Purim this year begins on Motzei Shabbat we will not be running the Purim party after Megillah. Instead, we are inviting the whole community to join the Spizzichinos at a special "Seuda Shlishit" on Shabbat afternoon (see above). Megilla will take place at **7.30pm** and will be read by **Dani Netzer**.

# <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> After Megilla there will be a private event held in the school hall from 8.15pm.

In addition, we have a Kiddush booked on **Shabbat 6 April** to honour those who have been running children's services this year and to honour all Horim V'Yeladim attendees with certificates (usually given out on Purim evening but deferred this year due to the simcha and it being Motzei Shabbat).

# **Purim Guidance Notes**

**Parashat Zachor:** On the Shabbat before Purim, it is obligatory to hear a special Torah reading from the end of Parshat Ki Tetze. This will take place in Shul not earlier that **10.30am** and will be repeated at the end of the Tefillah before Kiddush.

**Machatzit Hashekel:** This custom involves giving three half-shekel donations to commemorate the annual Temple tax, as described in Parshat Ki Sissa. Whilst this practice was historically linked to funding communal offerings in the Beit Hamikdash, it is now observed by giving a symbolic amount of money (3 x 50p's) to charity. This year, the custom is to make this donation on Taanit Esther (Thursday 21 March) at Mincha. As we don't have facilities for Mincha we will also have a collection available on Purim morning for those who require it.

**Matanot Levyonim:** This mitzvah involves giving gifts or donations to at least two needy individuals during the day of Purim. The purpose is to ensure that everyone can participate in the joyous festivities of the day. While there is no specific amount mandated, it is customary to give enough to enable the recipients to enjoy a meal (£10 suggested minimum amount). The Rabbi will be happy to distribute these funds to appropriate recipients on Purim day.

# This year, Purim falls on Motzei Shabbat, so here are some important reminders:-

- Recite "Baruch Hamavdil" before doing any Melacha or preparations for Megilla reading after Shabbat.
- One should refrain from changing clothes for Purim until after reciting Baruch Hamavdil. If one would wish to wear fancy dress costumes, please be mindful, this must be put on after Shabbat. (Please note, many Poskim suggest that one wears Shabbat clothes for the Megilla anyway)
- Remember not to bring the Megilla to Shul on Shabbat for use after Shabbat. This should be ideally brought on Friday.
