Guidance for Yamim Noraim

- Earliest time for lighting on erev-Rosh Hashana: 5.43pm.
- The **Shofar** will not be blown before **11.00am**. The full 100 blasts will be blown in shul, however an individual davening by themselves at home is only required to hear 30 blasts.
- 3. Tashlich is usually done before Mincha on the first day, but
- may be done even until Hoshana Rabba. No work for the 2nd day should be done before nightfall. Candle Lighting for 2nd night is after nightfall at **7.44pm**.
