- We will be upstairs for Succot with all our furniture moving on Monday 6 October. Please make sure to remove all desk items after Shabbat.
- Candle lighting (remember to light 2-day candle) on **Monday 6 October** from **5.17pm**
- Candle lighting from an existing flame on **Tuesday 7 October** from **7.12pm** | No work for the second day before nightfall at **7.12pm**
- Rain on first night:** if it seems the rain may stop, wait an hour or two for it to subside in order to recite full Kiddush and eat in the succah. If members of the household are hungry and/or tired and waiting will unduly disturb the enjoyment of Yom Tov then one is not required to wait. In such a case or if the rain appears steady and likely to continue throughout the night, one should make Kiddush (without the bracha of Leishev baSuccah) and eat a K'zayis of bread in the succah. The rest of the meal can continue in the house. If one has an opportunity to eat in the succah after the rain stops, then it is preferable to return to the succah, recite the bracha of Leishev BaSuccah and eat a k'beitzah of bread.


