Rabbi Mosheh Lichtenstein Short Biography.

Mosheh Lichtenstein is an Israeli rabbi, Talmud scholar, and educator. He serves as a Rosh Yeshiva (dean) at Yeshivat Har Etzion, one of the leading Modern Orthodox yeshivot in Israel. The son of Rabbi Aharon Lichtenstein, he is known for his teaching of Talmud, Jewish thought, and Tanakh, as well as for his writings on religious philosophy and contemporary Jewish issues. His work emphasizes rigorous Torah study alongside engagement with broader intellectual and ethical questions.
